Submission deadline: **September 1, 2026**

A. Scientific Research

Hypothesis-driven research presented as a multi-slide PowerPoint presentation available for electronic viewing to meeting attendees.

B. Education Exhibit

Visually-oriented multi-slide PowerPoint presentation designed to review an educational topic in neuroradiology and available for electronic viewing to meeting attendees.

C. Interesting Case

Interesting and educational individual case presented as a multi-slide PowerPoint presentation available for electronic viewing to meeting attendees.

A limited number of scientific research and interesting case submissions will be selected for oral presentation on **Saturday, October 17**.

All submissions will be considered for a limited number of monetary awards.

At least one of the authors of the accepted abstracts is expected to register for and attend the meeting.

D. Abstract Guidelines

- Abstracts should be submitted at tinyurl.com/SENRS26 by September 1, 2026.
- All categories of neuroradiology research and case presentations are accepted
- Scientific Research submissions should use the following format:
 - Purpose
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusion
- Education Exhibit submissions should use the following format:
 - Teaching Points
 - Outline
- Interesting Case submissions should use the following format:
 - Clinical Presentation
 - Imaging
 - Management
 - Outcome (if known)
 - Take home points
- Maximum abstract length: 3000 characters, not including Title, Authors, and Figure
- Submission of relevant images (up to 4) is encouraged as a single image file up to 10 MB
- Of note, just a brief abstract is needed for the initial submission. If accepted, instructions for submission of the final PowerPoint will be emailed to the authors.

E. Abstract Review Process

- Abstracts will be reviewed by members of the SENRS Education Committee
- Guidelines for presentation will be provided after abstract acceptance
- All submissions will be considered for a limited number of monetary awards (up to \$500)
- Abstract notifications to be sent by late August
